- 20:02 our people did not seem to fit into Cnd way of life as quickly as other immigrants (Buck Suzuki being interviewed - fisherman)
- 20:21 Greenwood (350 mi from Van.) evacuation/camp
- 20:38 the town... old hotel early 50's vehicles
- 20:56 W. MacArthur Mayor of Greenwood @ time interviewed "nobody wanted to have Jap." but here we could take them in + increase local economy. 48/ of 50 at meeting voted in favour those opposed did not come to meeting
- 25:25 Describes living quarters size # of rooms
- 26:18 various shots of interiors or quarters (empty rooms)
- 26:40 Narrator describes how improvement occurred in camps (as war goes on) Nisay (2nd generation Jap. Cnds. volunteer as translators in war)
- 27:10 describes the state of belongings 1/2 auctioned off at "ridiculous prices"
